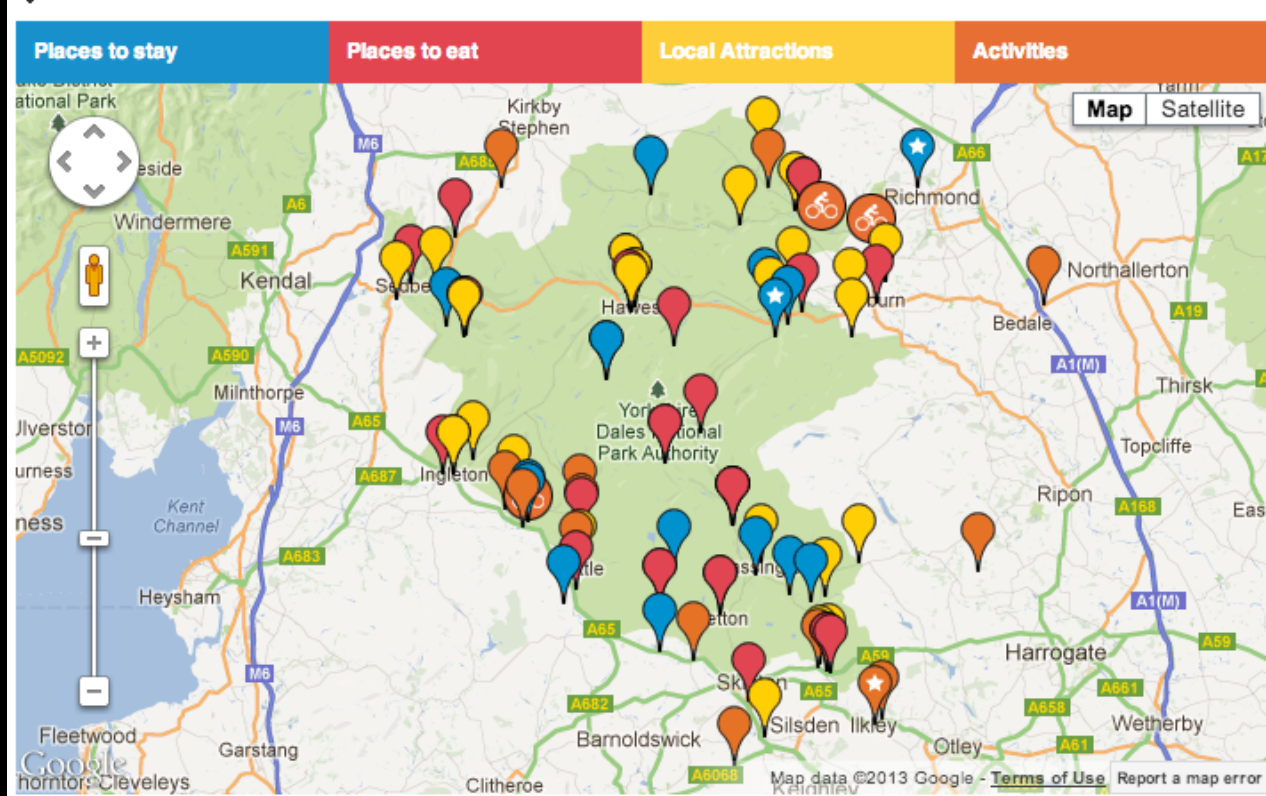

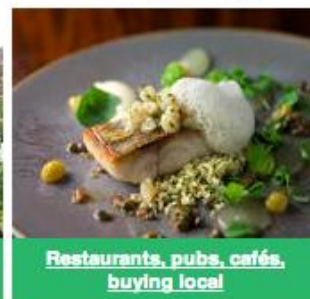

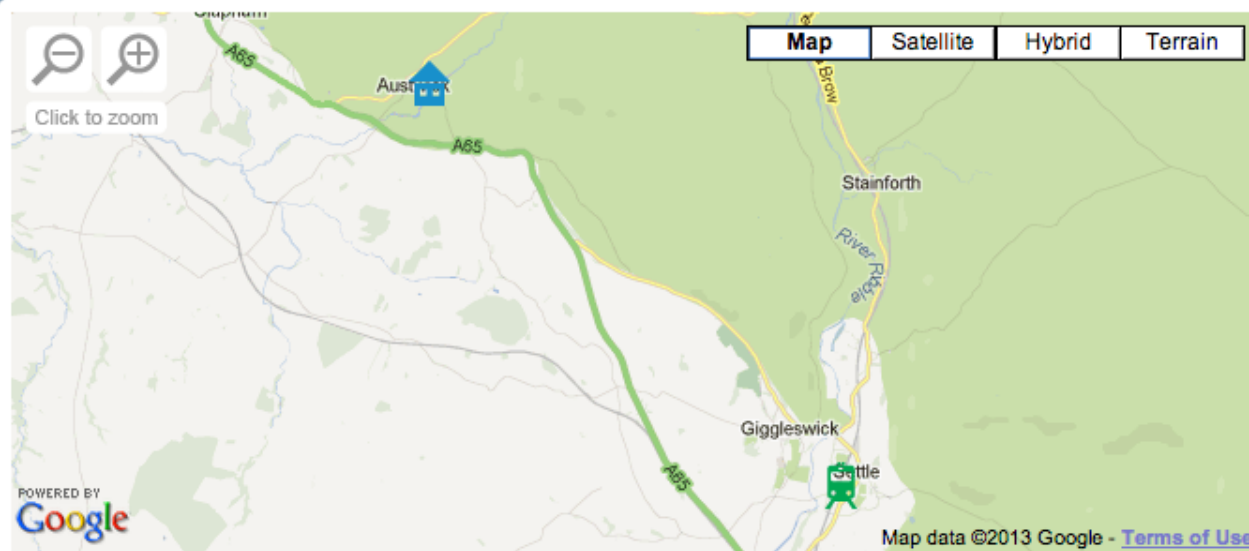

# The Value of Video

Video now accounts for half of all traffic on the internet
